SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Parishioners who would like to have their child baptized at St. Leo's are requested to call Father Hahn at the Parish Office to personally schedule an appointment to meet with him to discuss this great Sacrament. Normally Baptisms are held on the first Sunday of each month, after our 11:00 am Mass, or approximately at 12:00 Noon. At least one sponsor must be a practicing Catholic, age 16 or older, Confirmed, and must present a sponsor certificate if from another parish. Parents must be registered members of St. Leo's parish.

SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY

Couples contemplating marriage must contact Father Hahn at the Parish Office at least one year before the date of the intended marriage. Church date and arrangements should precede all other wedding plans.

SACRAMENT OF ANOINTING

Call any parish priest as soon as there is any serious illness.

HOLY COMMUNION TO THE SICK

When a parishioner is confined to home because of illness, advanced age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office and arrangements will be made to bring Holy Communion to the person.

RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS (RCIA)

Adults interested in learning more about their faith or in becoming Catholic may join the program of formation and instruction which begins in September. Call the Religious Education Office.

“Whoever drinks the water I shall give will never thirst; the water I shall give will become in him a spring of water welling up to eternal life.” (John 4:13-14)

We hear these words today as part of the Gospel of the encounter between Jesus and the Samaritan Woman at Jacob’s Well. It is such a profound encounter that begins with the Son of God simply saying to the woman, “give me a drink.” He engages her. She is startled and responds how is it that He is asking her that question. And, of course, all of it is to point to the symbolism and the reality of water, and how God offers us that water of His life, “welling up to eternal life.”

We need to pause a bit because water is so easily available to us and it is easy to overlook the context of this encounter. For those in Jesus’ time, their living in that desert climate meant that they needed to seek out water, to ensure that they had it for themselves and for their families to survive.

We know how important water is for us, how to be healthy we need to drink so much of it each day. But then, we need to see the imagery in the context of our Faith, that while natural water is important to us for physical health and life, the “water” of God’s grace is essential for us in the spiritual realm. The “water” that He gives is His very life and His love. It is the gift of His infinite mercy, which is the only thing that can offer us eternal life in Him. It is the gift of Himself in the Holy Eucharist that we share as He gives to us the “refreshment” of His Body and Blood at every Mass.

The past few days have been such blessed ones for our Parish. Father Meinert led us in our Forty Hours Devotion. He spoke of Our Lord’s presence in the Holy Eucharist and reflected for our three nights of Evening Prayer, upon the three different titles of “Lamb of God”; “Bread of Angels” and “Bread of Life.” On Tuesday evening, we gathered as a Parish Family and dedicated our new Parish Hall/School Auditorium, the fruit of the generosity of so many in our Parish over the years. Twelve years ago, we began the process of our Parish, looking to the future, seeking God’s guidance and grace to build His Kingdom here among us. We completed the renovations of our Church in 2012, then the expansion and modernization of our School in 2015 and now, this last part of that vision, our new Parish Hall. I am so grateful to so many, some of whom over these years, have been called home to the Lord. I pray for all of you that God may bless you for your great generosity and sacrifice.

In our First Reading today, we hear of the Israelites, as they journeyed through the desert to their destination of freedom in the Promised Land. This, of course, symbolizes our journey from sin to the freedom of His grace. The Samaritan woman opened herself to that most wonderful encounter with the Living God and she was introduced to the power of His “life giving water”. May we do that too, availing ourselves of that greatest refreshment of the forgiveness of our sins in the Sacrament of Penance and Reconciliation, that we’ll celebrate as a Parish in two and a half weeks, on Tuesday, March 28th. Then, filled with His mercy and peace, we’ll best prepare in this Lent, looking ahead to the wondrous joy of Easter and the eternal life He offers to us.

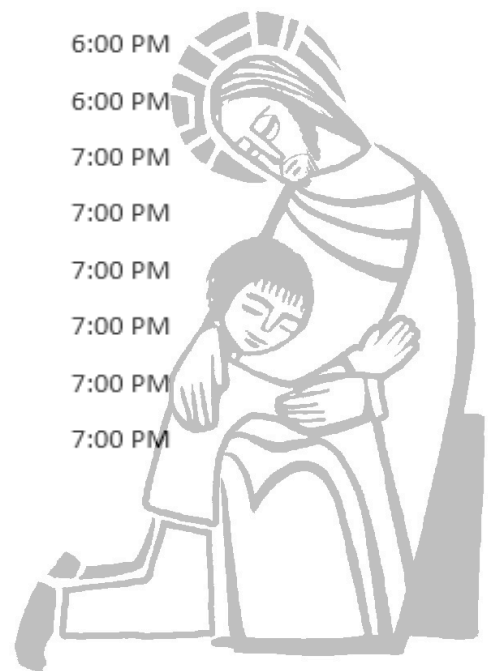

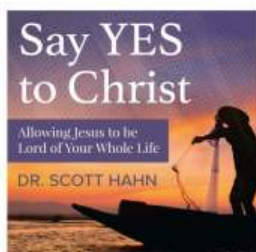
The Story of Death Eternal Rest Episode 1
