SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Parishioners who would like to have their child baptized at St. Leo's are requested to call Father Hahn at the Parish Office to personally schedule an appointment to meet with him to discuss this great Sacrament. Normally Baptisms are held on the first Sunday of each month, after our 11:00 am Mass, or approximately at 12:00 Noon. At least one sponsor must be a practicing Catholic, age 16 or older, Confirmed, and must present a sponsor certificate if from another parish. Parents must be registered members of St. Leo's parish.

SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY

Couples contemplating marriage must contact Father Hahn at the Parish Office at least one year before the date of the intended marriage. Church date and arrangements should precede all other wedding plans.

SACRAMENT OF ANOINTING

Call any parish priest as soon as there is any serious illness.

HOLY COMMUNION TO THE SICK

When a parishioner is confined to home because of illness, advanced age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office and arrangements will be made to bring Holy Communion to the person.

RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS (RCIA)

Adults interested in learning more about their faith or in becoming Catholic may join the program of formation and instruction which begins in September. Call the Religious Education Office.

SPONSOR CERTIFICATES

Letters of recommendation for sponsors of the Sacraments can be issued only to active registered members of the parish and who are receiving the Sacraments on a regular basis.

History of Saint Leo the Great Catholic Church – Part 5

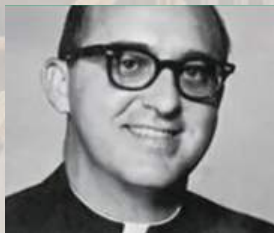
Over the course of the past 60 years, Saint Leo the Great Catholic Church has been blessed by the spiritual leadership of three devoted pastors.

The Rev. Edward J. Deller, Saint Leo's founding pastor, led our parish for the first 17 years beginning in 1967. He worked tirelessly to build our community of faith. Father Deller retired in 1981 and was succeeded by Rev. William J. Sullivan.

Father Sullivan served for 27 years, and all who were fortunate to know him or were here during his pastorate, were certainly touched by his deep faith and gentle spirit.

Upon Father Sullivan's retirement in June 2008, the Rev. Peter I. Hahn was assigned to our parish.

With the arrival of our new pastor and his great love of the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass came a new vision to beautify, update and expand our parish campus. This included the renovations to the Daily Chapel, Sanctuary, and the interior of the church – along with the school modernization and addition. The new Parish Hall was completed in 2022.

Sacramental Policy for the Reception of Confirmation and Holy Eucharist: Preparation for the Sacraments of Confirmation and Holy Eucharist is a two-year program as prescribed by the Diocese of Harrisburg. To be eligible to receive the sacrament of Confirmation, your child must have completed the 7th and 8th grade years of instruction and to receive the sacrament of Holy Eucharist your child must have completed the 1st and 2nd grade years of instruction at either our Parish Elementary School or our Parish School of Religion. Campers: Campers pay a fee to attend camp and some counties subsidize the cost, but donations are welcomed to support the Diocese in offering the experience.

Volunteers: There is no cost to our dedicated volunteers; all meals, events, campground activities, etc. are included.

Don't miss this great opportunity to experience the Passion, Death and Resurrection of Jesus Christ in a way that can make this an unforgettable event in your life.

Considered one of the greatest mysteries of our time, the Shroud of Turin continues to amaze and baffle scientists, doctors, historians, artists and theologians.
