## SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Parishioners who would like to have their child baptized at St. Leo's are requested to call Father Hahn at the Parish Office to personally schedule an appointment to meet with him to discuss this great Sacrament. Normally Baptisms are held on the first Sunday of each month, after our 11:00 am Mass, or approximately at 12:00 Noon. At least one sponsor must be a practicing Catholic, age 16 or older, Confirmed, and must present a sponsor certificate if from another parish. Parents must be registered members of St. Leo's parish.

## SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY

Couples contemplating marriage must contact Father Hahn at the Parish Office at least one year before the date of the intended marriage. Church date and arrangements should precede all other wedding plans.

## SACRAMENT OF ANOINTING

Call any parish priest as soon as there is any serious illness.

## HOLY COMMUNION TO THE SICK

When a parishioner is confined to home because of illness, advanced age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office and arrangements will be made to bring Holy Communion to the person.

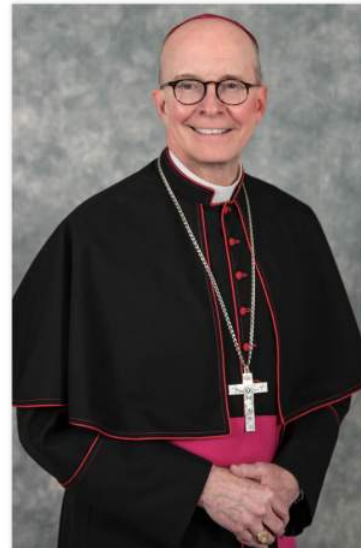


*You will make a difference in people's lives through your witness to Christ.*

The conditions in number 2 can be fulfilled a few days before or after performing the works below to gain the indulgence, but it is appropriate that Communion and the prayer take place on the same day that the work is completed.

## Complete one of the following six works:



**Undertake a pious pilgrimage to one of the Diocesan Sacred Sites and completing one of the following:**

- a. devoutly participating in Holy Mass or the Anointing of the Sick
- b. a celebration of the Word of God;
- c. the Liturgy of the Hours
- d. the Way of the Cross;
- e. the Marian Rosary;
- f. a penitential celebration, which ends with the individual confessions of the penitents.



**Carry out a corporal or spiritual work of mercy**



**Carry out a work of Penance**

Such as abstaining, fasting, donating money to the poor, by supporting works of a religious or social nature, especially in support of the defence, protection and quality of life in all its phases, or by volunteering free time to activities that are of service to the community.



**By devoutly visiting one of the Diocesan Sacred Sites**

For a suitable period of time, engage in Eucharistic adoration and meditation, concluding with the Our Father, the Apostles Creed, and the Hail Mary.



**Participate in Missions, Spiritual Exercises or formation activities,**

with a devout spirit, on the documents of the Second Vatican Council and the Catechism of the Catholic Church, held in a church or other suitable place.



**Those who are sick or cannot participate for serious reasons, can obtain the Jubilee Indulgence**

If, united in spirit with the faithful taking part in person, they recite the Our Father, the Apostles Creed and the Jubilee Prayer, offering up their sufferings or the hardships of their lives.

## Week of Prayer for Christian Unity

The Week of Prayer for Christian Unity will be observed from January 18-25, 2025. All of the faithful are encouraged to engage in activities which foster unity and reconciliation among Christian groups, including ecumenical dialogue, joint charitable service, and participation in services of prayer for Christian unity. 2025 will mark two significant anniversaries:

-The 1700th anniversary of the Council of Nicaea (held from May-July 325). This would be an ideal year to study that Council in union with other Christians who profess the Nicene Creed. The Creed, Canons, and Synodal Letter can be accessed at <https://www.newadvent.org/fathers/3801.htm>. *Early Christian Doctrines* and *Early Christian Creeds* by J.N.D. Kelly are helpful resources for understanding the background and text of the Creed.

-The 500th anniversary of the beginning of the Anabaptist Movement, which includes the Amish and Mennonites. Since the Harrisburg Diocese has significant populations of Anabaptists, this would be an opportune time to engage in dialogue. A Catholic-Anabaptist dialogue event is planned for the evening of April 11 in Lancaster. More details will be forthcoming.
