SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

At least one sponsor must be a practicing Catholic, age 16 or older, Confirmed, and must present a sponsor certificate if from another parish. Parents must be registered members of St. Leo's parish.

“While He was praying, His face changed in appearance and His clothing became dazzling white...[Then] from the cloud came a voice that said, ‘This is my chosen Son; listen to Him.’” (Luke 9:29; 35)

Each year on this Second Sunday of Lent, we hear of the event of the Transfiguration. Peter, James and John are taken to a mountain where the appearance of Jesus dramatically changes. Moses and Elijah, representing the Law and the Prophets, appear. We hear that Peter, James and John are terrified and then, a voice says, “This is my chosen Son, listen to Him.”

It is generally understood that Jesus underwent this “transformation” to strengthen these Apostles as they would soon be faced with the horror of the cross. Of course, only John would remain with His Blessed Mother there, in that indescribable pain and loss. And then, in a Lenten Homily, our Patron, Saint Leo the Great gives us an additional insight when he writes that Jesus “was also providing a firm foundation for the hope of holy Church. The whole body of Christ was to understand the kind of transformation that it would receive as His gift. The members of that body were to look forward to a share in that glory which first blazed out in Christ their Head.”

Isn’t this a marvelous teaching; that we too are meant to be “transfigured” one day in eternal splendor? And this, of course, is the whole point of Lent. Ten days ago, on Ash Wednesday, we heard Jesus’ words from His famous Sermon on the Mount recorded in the Gospel of Saint Matthew; that three-part regimen of Lent to which He continuously calls us - “to pray, fast and give alms”. We are called to do these things so that we might be changed, transformed by His grace. We “fast” as the Church prescribes and as we voluntarily choose. We “give alms”, most notably in what used to be called our Annual Lenten Appeal, now the Diocesan Annual Campaign, when we are called to help the poor and needy of our Diocese.

And now, for these next three days, our Parish has that special opportunity “to pray” as we gather for our Forty Hours Devotions. On this Sunday, Monday and Tuesday, beginning after the last Mass each day, Our Lord, in His Eucharistic Presence, will be in the Monstrance, placed on our Altar for prayer and adoration. We will have that opportunity to “come to Him”, and to follow what that “voice from the cloud” says, to “listen to Him”. Each evening, over these next three days, we will gather at 7:00 p.m. to celebrate Evening Prayer.

These days are special for us. Particularly, if one spends one-half hour in prayer and adoration before the Blessed Sacrament, one may be able to receive a Plenary Indulgence, which acts to remove all “temporal punishment due to sin”, that residual aspect of our sin that remains even after sin has been forgiven. We can either receive this grace or we can apply it to one in Purgatory, so that this person would be immediately brought into the glory of heaven.

So let us avail ourselves of this great blessing over these days. Let us come before our Eucharistic Lord, and say, as Peter did, “Master, it is good that we are here.” And then, let us listen to Him and be transformed by Him, as we continue in this journey of life that we pray will lead us all one day, to that ultimate transformation meant for us one day, forever in heaven.

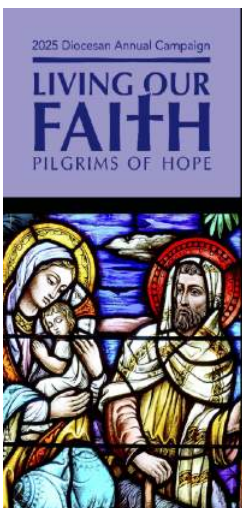
