## SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

At least one sponsor must be a practicing Catholic, age 16 or older, Confirmed, and must present a sponsor certificate if from another parish. Parents must be registered members of St. Leo's parish.

**“Whoever drinks the water I shall give will never thirst; the water I shall give will become in him a spring of water welling up to eternal life.” (John 4:13-14)**

Today’s Gospel brings us to that most dramatic encounter between Jesus and the Samaritan Woman at Jacob’s Well. I just love how this event that will forever change this woman’s life begins. She is simply engaged in the normal event of her day, but an important one, as she must get the water that she needs. Jesus is sitting there and as she comes forward, He simply says, “give me a drink.”

But how startling this is! She, of course, is shocked for a Jewish man would never engage a Samaritan woman. But, this is no ordinary Jewish Man. This is the eternal God, who has come to draw our human nature to Himself and so He continues the dialogue.

There is great symbolism in all of this as this is exactly how God still engages each and every one of us. He is with us in all that we do, in our work and our play, in our joys and sufferings, and all He ever does is offer us that greatest gift of His presence and His peace, represented by that most basic element of water.

We know how important water is for us, how to be healthy we need to drink so much of it each day. But then, we need the meaning behind all of this; that while water is important to us for physical health and life, the “water” of God’s grace is essential for us in the spiritual realm. The “water” that He gives is His very life and His love. It is the gift of His infinite mercy, which is the only thing that can offer us eternal life and it is the gift of Himself in the Holy Eucharist that gives us the ultimate “refreshment”.

The past few days have been such blessed ones for our Parish. So many spent time during the day in silent Adoration of our Lord in His Eucharistic Presence and Father Kappes led us in our Forty Hours Devotions on Sunday, Monday and Tuesday evenings. I am so grateful for his priestly service to us and he inspired us with his insights and reflections.

On Tuesday evening, so many of us gathered for a wonderful meal provide by Eastern Palace and we were blessed with the presence of other priests of our Diocese. We continue in this Jubilee Year to especially pray for Vocations to the Priesthood and Consecrated Life and I thank our Vocation Ministry Team for their dedication.

We are so blessed and we have so much for which we are thankful. Our First Reading today shows to us what we need to avoid, that “grumbling” that can afflict us as it did those Chosen People travelling through the desert. May we always find “refreshment” in the fullness of God’s mercy as we look to our Parish Lenten Penance Service coming up in 10 days on Tuesday, April 1<sup>st</sup>, to then be strengthened in our continuing Lenten journey to that glorious event of Easter, and then one day, to that Eternal Life that His resurrection shows is ours.
