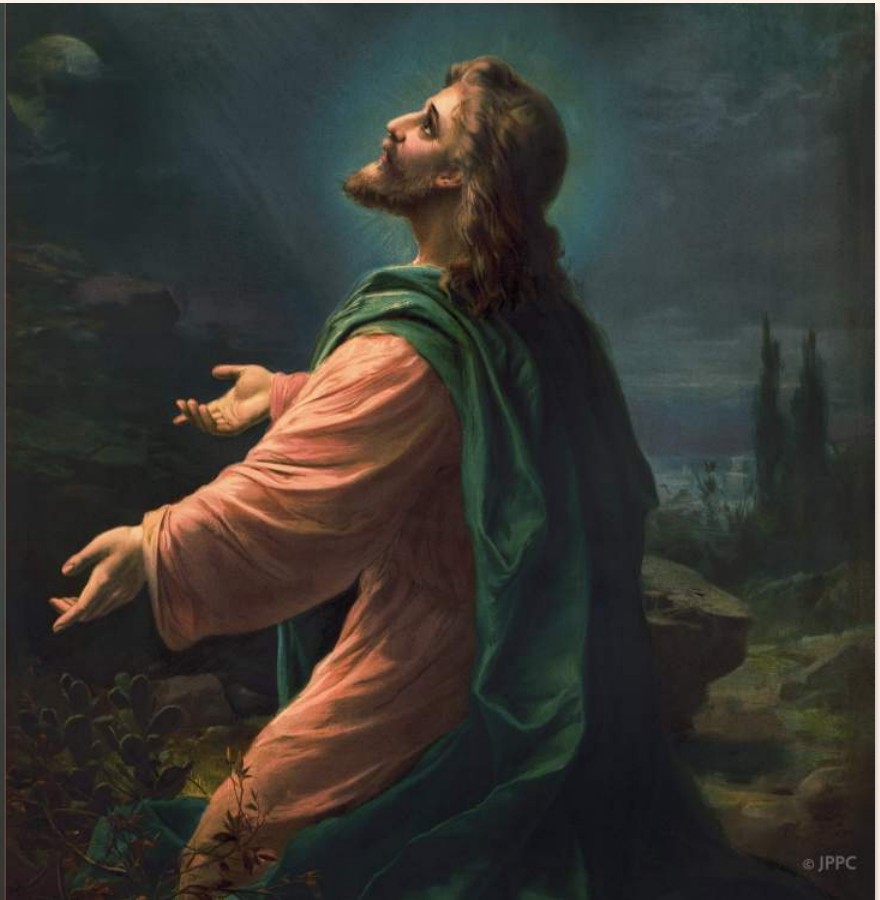

SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Parishioners who would like to have their child baptized at St. Leo's are requested to call Monsignor Hahn at the Parish Office to personally schedule an appointment to meet with him to discuss this great Sacrament. Normally Baptisms are held on the first Sunday of each month, after our 11:00 am Mass, or approximately at 12:00 Noon. At least one sponsor must be a practicing Catholic, age 16 or older, Confirmed, and must present a sponsor certificate if from another parish. Parents must be registered members of St. Leo's parish.

SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY

Couples contemplating marriage must contact Monsignor Hahn at the Parish Office at least one year before the date of the intended marriage. Church date and arrangements should precede all other wedding plans.

SACRAMENT OF ANOINTING

Call any parish priest as soon as there is any serious illness.

HOLY COMMUNION TO THE SICK

When a parishioner is confined to home because of illness, advanced age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office and arrangements will be made to bring Holy Communion to the person.

RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS (RCIA)

Adults interested in learning more about their faith or in becoming Catholic may join the program of formation and instruction which begins in September. Call the Religious Education Office.

“Jesus prayed, saying: ‘Holy Father, I pray not only for them but also for those who will believe in me through their word, so that they may all be one, as you, Father, are in me and I in you, that they also may be in us, that the world may believe that you sent me”
(John 17:20-21)

We come together on this Seventh Sunday of Easter, having celebrated the Solemnity of the Ascension this past Thursday and now, looking forward to next Sunday’s completion of our Easter Season with the glorious event of Pentecost.

For all of us in the Church, this Season has been especially momentous. On Easter Sunday morning in Rome, Pope Francis appeared in Saint Peter’s Square and travelled throughout the crowd blessing them as the world marked the Resurrection. He died the next day, on Easter Monday, and all of us then witnessed the world come together to mourn his passing, to see the beauty of the Funeral Mass as millions throughout the world prayed for him and the Church. And then, with great joy, on May 8th, the Thursday of the Third Week of Easter, we joyfully celebrated the election of Pope Leo XIV, the first one born in the United States to ever be named as the successor to Saint Peter.

While we have mourned, anticipated, and then celebrated these days, I think it is noteworthy to acknowledge that “we” have done so, that all of us in the Church are united to one another in Faith, Hope and Love, called to always live out that unity. In the words above, from our Gospel today, Jesus prays that all “may be one, as you Father are in me and I in you.”

Unity is the core aspect and defining characteristic of our Faith. It is the very essence of God, who is Three Persons but One God, and it is how we authentically then live out our faith, united to one another, not by focusing on self and selfish desires, but focusing on God and His call to love one another. As Pope Leo XIV stated in the homily at his Inauguration Mass last Sunday: “I would like that our first great desire be for a united Church, a sign of unity and communion, which becomes a leaven for a reconciled world.”

On a personal note, today, June 1st is a special day for both Father Kappes and me as it marks the anniversary of our being ordained to the Priesthood; for me, now having completed 23 years, for Father Kappes, his first. We humbly ask for your prayers as I know I speak for Father Kappes in saying that I cannot describe the awe and wonder that I experience each day as I celebrate the Sacred Mysteries of our Faith and try to lead others to Christ.

As a Parish, we will welcome Deacon Drew Heidelbaugh this week. Deacon Drew was ordained two weeks ago on May 17th and will be with us throughout the Summer until returning for his Fourth Year of Seminary at Saint Charles Borromeo in August. He will then be with us for most weekends leading to, hopefully, his Ordination to the Priesthood next June.

And so, as we continue in the Easter celebration, let us pray for one another, that all of us may be more fully united to Christ, whom we receive in this Holy Eucharist, and then live out that unity and love more authentically each day. Happy Easter!
