SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Normally Baptisms are held on the first Sunday of each month, after our 11:00 am Mass, or approximately at 12:00 Noon. At least one sponsor must be a practicing Catholic, age 16 or older, Confirmed, and must present a sponsor certificate if from another parish. Parents must be registered members of St. Leo's parish.

SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY

Couples contemplating marriage must contact Father Hahn at the Parish Office at least one year before the date of the intended marriage. Church date and arrangements should precede all other wedding plans.

SACRAMENT OF ANOINTING

Call any parish priest as soon as there is any serious illness.

HOLY COMMUNION TO THE SICK

When a parishioner is confined to home because of illness, advanced age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office and arrangements will be made to bring Holy Communion to the person.

RITE OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS (RCIA)

Adults interested in learning more about their faith or in becoming Catholic may join the program of formation and instruction which begins in September. Call the Religious Education Office.

Prison Ministry Gathering for Chaplains and Volunteers

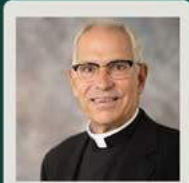

Saint Rita of Cascia

Feast Day: 5/22/25

St. Rita of Cascia (1381-1457) is a patron saint of the impossible, difficult and hopeless causes, distinctly in the realm of marriage, abuse, fertility, parenthood, and disease.



In her basilica in Cascia, Italy is a Eucharistic relic from a miracle that occurred in 1330. A priest took a consecrated Host and irreverently placed it in the pages of his breviary and quickly went to take Holy Communion to a sick peasant. Upon arriving at the peasant's home, he opened his book to find the host was stained with blood, marking both pages. The blood-stained pages can be seen and venerated today.

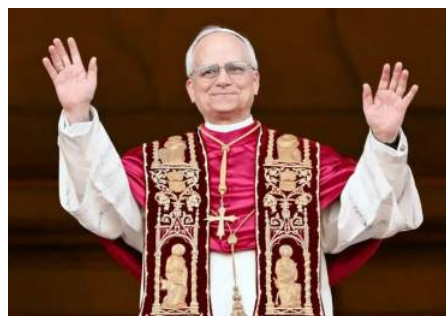
