SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Parishioners who would like to have their child baptized at St. Leo's are requested to call Father Hahn at the Parish Office to personally schedule an appointment to meet with him to discuss this great Sacrament. Normally Baptisms are held on the first Sunday of each month, after our 11:00 am Mass, or approximately at 12:00 Noon. At least one sponsor must be a practicing Catholic, age 16 or older, Confirmed, and must present a sponsor certificate if from another parish. Parents must be registered members of St. Leo's parish.

SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY

Couples contemplating marriage must contact Father Hahn at the Parish Office at least one year before the date of the intended marriage. Church date and arrangements should precede all other wedding plans.

SACRAMENT OF ANOINTING

Call any parish priest as soon as there is any serious illness.

HOLY COMMUNION TO THE SICK

When a parishioner is confined to home because of illness, advanced age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office and arrangements will be made to bring Holy Communion to the person.

What a remarkable example of generosity by the people of St. Leo's we experienced with the April collection of food for the Hempfield Food Pantry. It was the largest amount ever given - 1,339 pounds. St. Leo's school donated an additional 352 pounds. What a blessing this is for local people facing food insecurity. 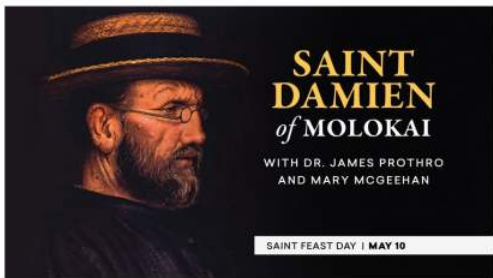

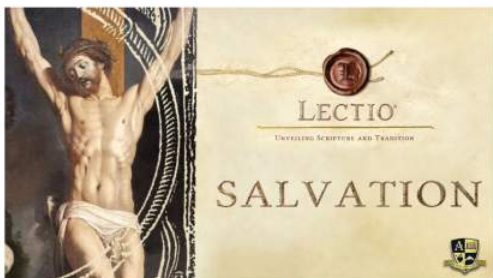

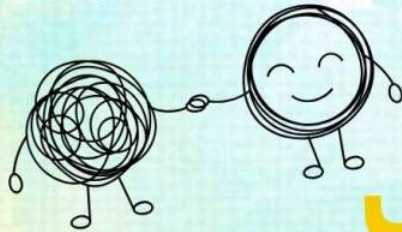

Jayne has worked for WellSpan (formally Philhaven) since 2003 and currently serves as a Social Service Specialist with the Arches to Wellness Program. Jayne is a certified trainer for Mental Health First Aid USA, QPR (Question, Persuade, Refer), Trauma-Informed Care 101/102, and Trauma-Informed Response for First Responders and was listed in the top 20 trainers, out of 18,000, for MHFA USA in 2018 and top 10 out of 21,000 in 2019. With this first-hand knowledge and experience, Jayne has a unique understanding of the need for de-stigmatization of mental health concerns and a keen sense of the need for early prevention/intervention. She believes if we build a more productive society through engagement and knowledge, we can encourage each other to live our lives with meaning and purpose.
