SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Parishioners who would like to have their child baptized at St. Leo's are requested to call Monsignor Hahn at the Parish Office to personally schedule an appointment to meet with him to discuss this great Sacrament. Normally Baptisms are held on the first Sunday of each month, after our 11:00 am Mass, or approximately at 12:00 Noon. At least one sponsor must be a practicing Catholic, age 16 or older, Confirmed, and must present a sponsor certificate if from another parish. Parents must be registered members of St. Leo's parish.

SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY

Couples contemplating marriage must contact Monsignor Hahn at the Parish Office at least one year before the date of the intended marriage. Church date and arrangements should precede all other wedding plans.

SACRAMENT OF ANOINTING

Call any parish priest as soon as there is any serious illness.

HOLY COMMUNION TO THE SICK

When a parishioner is confined to home because of illness, advanced age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office and arrangements will be made to bring Holy Communion to the person.

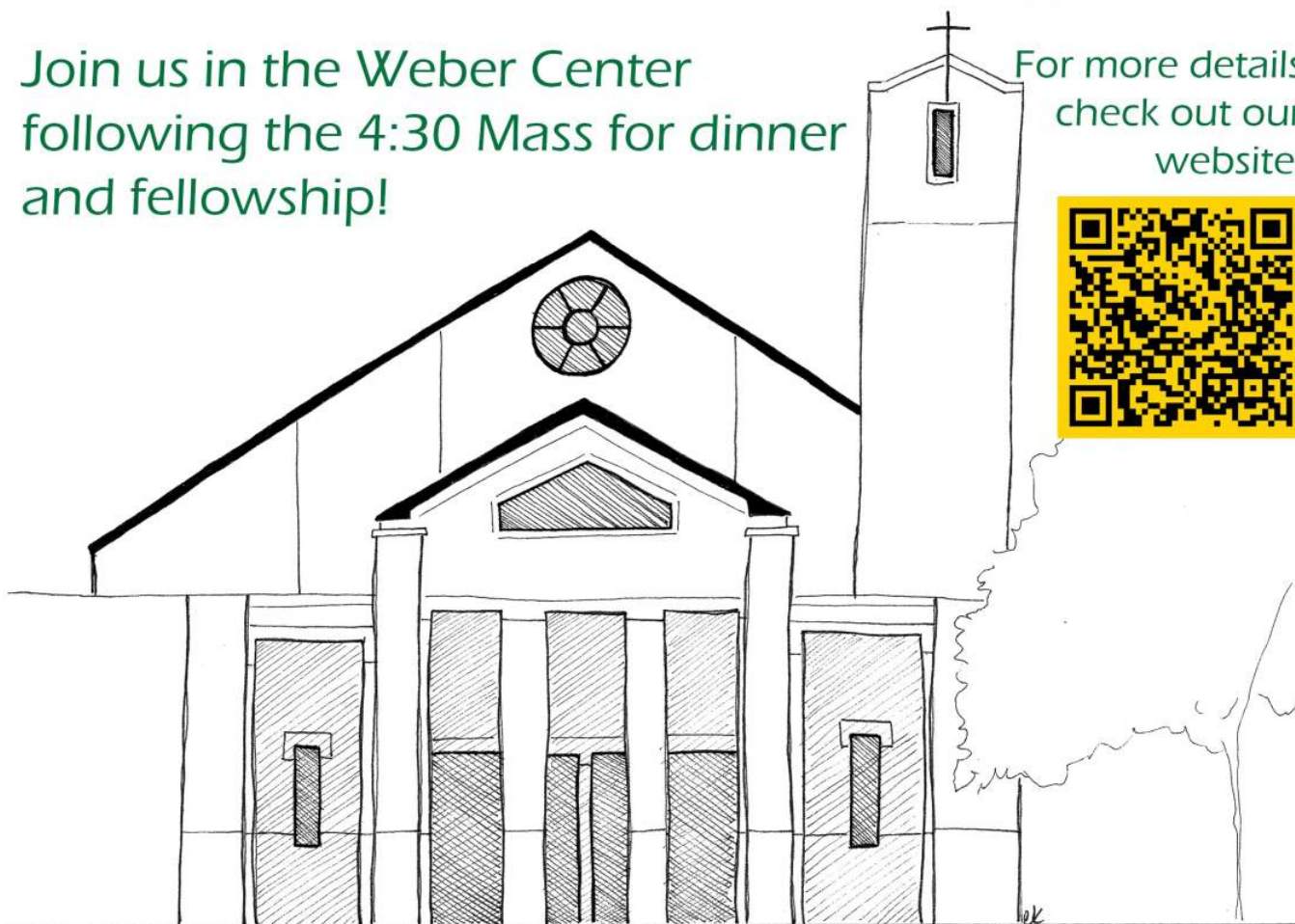

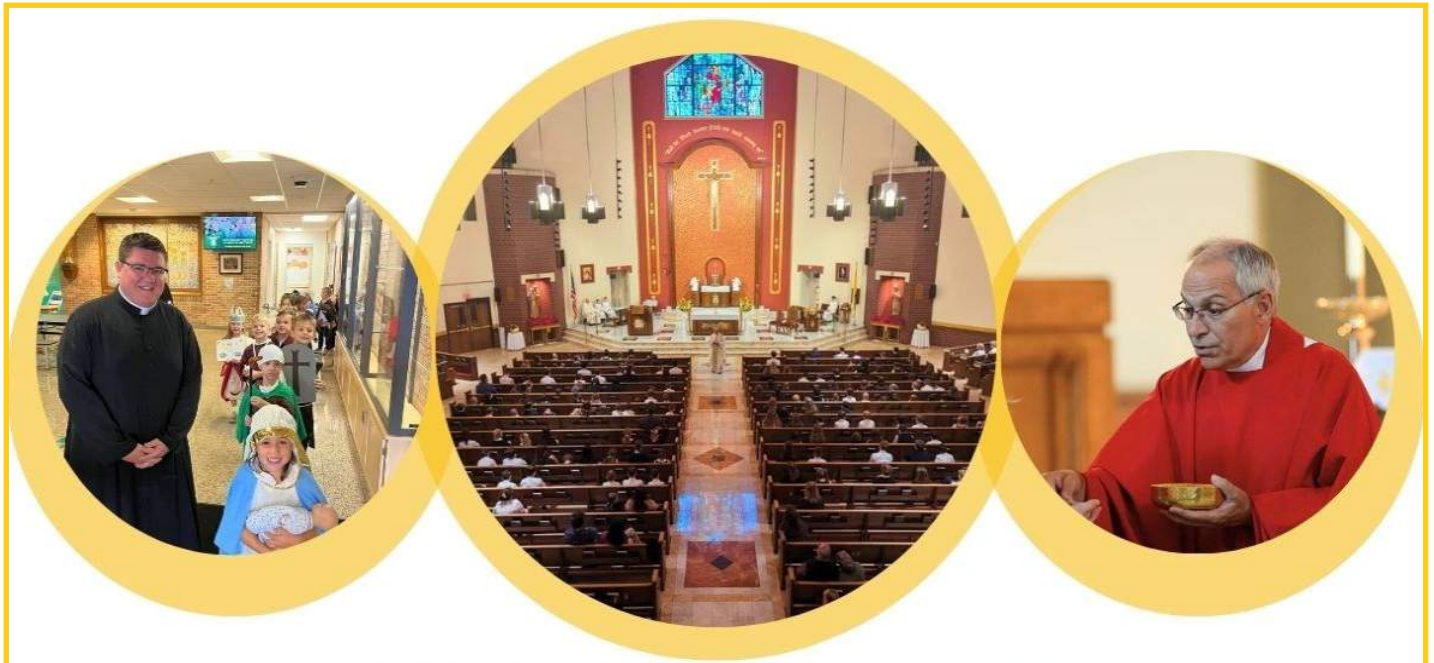

The Holy Veil of Manoppello: Image of the Living Face of Jesus



In 1915, an earthquake leveled Manoppello, Italy. Christendom's long-lost small cloth that lay over Jesus' face in the tomb was discovered in the local church's rubble. This small veil, now known as the Holy Face of Manoppello, absorbed the very first breath of the Risen Christ and imprinted on itself miraculously a vivid image of the resurrected Jesus. Modern scholars have confirmed that this image corresponds perfectly in all its measurements to the face of the dead Christ on the Shroud of Turin. In an extraordinary gesture, the National Centre for Padre Pio is honored to have been chosen as the only location on the East Coast of the United States to house an authentic relic image of the Holy Face of Manoppello which will permanently remain on exposition. Join us for the enthronement of the relic image of the Holy Veil with Bishop Alfred Schlert and Padre Antonio Gentili, OFM, Capuchin presiding.

The conditions in number 2 can be fulfilled a few days before or after performing the works below to gain the indulgence, but it is appropriate that Communion and the prayer take place on the same day that the work is completed.

Complete one of the following six works:



Undertake a pious pilgrimage to one of the Diocesan Sacred Sites and completing one of the following:

- a. devoutly participating in Holy Mass or the Anointing of the Sick
- b. a celebration of the Word of God;
- c. the Liturgy of the Hours
- d. the Way of the Cross;
- e. the Marian Rosary;
- f. a penitential celebration, which ends with the individual confessions of the penitents.



Carry out a corporal or spiritual work of mercy



Carry out a work of Penance

Such as abstaining, fasting, donating money to the poor, by supporting works of a religious or social nature, especially in support of the defence, protection and quality of life in all its phases, or by volunteering free time to activities that are of service to the community.



By devoutly visiting one of the Diocesan Sacred Sites

For a suitable period of time, engage in Eucharistic adoration and meditation, concluding with the Our Father, the Apostles Creed, and the Hail Mary.



Participate in Missions, Spiritual Exercises or formation activities,

with a devout spirit, on the documents of the Second Vatican Council and the Catechism of the Catholic Church, held in a church or other suitable place.



Those who are sick or cannot participate for serious reasons, can obtain the Jubilee Indulgence

If, united in spirit with the faithful taking part in person, they recite the Our Father, the Apostles Creed and the Jubilee Prayer, offering up their sufferings or the hardships of their lives.

The Origins of Corpus Christi

In 1263, a Bohemian priest named Peter of Prague was struggling with belief in transubstantiation. He doubted that the bread and wine became Jesus' body and blood. Peter stopped in Bolsena, Italy to celebrate Mass while on his pilgrimage to Rome. During the consecration, the host began to bleed, staining the corporal (the square linen cloth on which rests the chalice and paten). Peter of Prague took the blood-stained corporal to Pope Urban IV in Orvieto. After an investigation, he declared it a miracle. The relic was enshrined in Orvieto Cathedral. This miracle inspired Pope Urban IV to declare the Feast of Corpus Christi in 1264. The Pope recruited St. Thomas Aquinas to compose the liturgy for this sacred feast. One of the hymns he composed is *Adoro Te Devote*, a prayer frequently used today during Benediction or sung during Eucharistic processions.
