SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Normally Baptisms are held on the first Sunday of each month, after our 11:00 am Mass, or approximately at 12:00 Noon. At least one sponsor must be a practicing Catholic, age 16 or older, Confirmed, and must present a sponsor certificate if from another parish. Parents must be registered members of St. Leo's parish.

Couples contemplating marriage must contact Monsignor Hahn at the Parish Office at least one year before the date of the intended marriage. Church date and arrangements should precede all other wedding plans.

SACRAMENT OF ANOINTING

When a parishioner is confined to home because of illness, advanced age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office and arrangements will be made to bring Holy Communion to the person.

“Jesus said to them again, ‘Peace be with you’ . . . and when He had said this, He breathed on them and said to them, ‘Receive the Holy Spirit. Whose sins you forgive are forgiven them, and whose sins you retain are retained.’” John 20:23

These words of our Gospel today recall that sending of the Holy Spirit to the Church at Pentecost, and they capture, in such brevity, the boundless power and gift that the Holy Spirit, God Himself, always offers to us, the gift of “peace” and how we can find that priceless gift, most wonderfully, in the forgiveness of our sins.

Today, on Pentecost Sunday, we recall this sending of the Holy Spirit and how that Spirit continues to pour out His presence among us, to see then how this One Spirit of God is meant to unite us, but each in a unique and personal way. Saint Cyril of Jerusalem, a Fourth Century Bishop, puts it this way: “Water comes down from heaven as rain, and although it is always the same in itself, it produces many different effects, one in the palm tree, another in the vine and so on throughout the whole of creation. In the same way, the Holy Spirit, whose nature is always the same, simple and indivisible, apportions grace to each man as He wills.”

We celebrate in a special way in our Diocese the ordinations, yesterday, in our Cathedral, of Fathers Cole Mase, Andrew St. Denis, and Clark Steitler. We rejoice in the sending of the Holy Spirit in a most powerful way to configure them to Christ, the One Eternal High Priest. We pray that God will bless them with many years of faithful service to the people of our Diocese.

And this weekend, we welcome Deacon Drew Heidelbaugh who will serve here in our Parish for this summer and then, on weekends, during the next School Year as he completes his studies at Saint Charles Borromeo Seminary in Philadelphia. Deacon Drew is a 2017 graduate of Cumberland Valley High School and has shared with me how, when in High School, a friend invited him to Quo Vadis Days, the annual Discernment Retreat of our Diocese at Mount Saint Mary’s in Emmitsburg, MD. He “wrestled” with the call to the Priesthood, he said, for about six months or so before as he said to me most simply, “I thought if God wanted me to be a Priest, I guess I would be a Priest.” What a beautiful expression and example of God’s Holy Spirit guiding a young man to such a momentous decision!

And so, we look forward to Deacon Drew’s time with us, as we pray for him in this final year of his preparation for Ordination. We pray that God might continue to fill all of us with those twelve fruits of the Holy Spirit, which are written on both sides of the walls of our Church, to live more fully, each day, in “charity, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, generosity, gentleness, faithfulness, modesty, self-control, chastity.”

Let’s strive to do that so that, again, by the power of God’s mercy, we might know the fullness of His joy and peace.

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Today we conclude the Easter Season with the celebration of Pentecost. On this “Birthday of the Church,” we remember the outpouring of the Holy Spirit on the Apostles, who were huddled in fear in the Upper Room. The Holy Spirit filled them with courage and purpose as they embarked upon their mission to share the good news of Jesus with the world. This spirit of unity and action is something we are all called to embrace (accept), yet some men in our communities are called in a special way – they are called to the sacred order of the Priesthood.

As Rector of Saint Charles Borromeo Seminary in Philadelphia, I understood firsthand the need for proper formation for our future priests. These men, once ordained, would lead their local flocks in the faith, administer the Sacraments, and be spiritual fathers. As Pope Leo said: “Walking along the shore, Jesus had called Peter and the other first disciples to be, like him, “fishers of men”. Now, after the resurrection, it is up to them to carry on this mission, to cast their nets again and again, to bring the hope of the Gospel into the “waters” of the world, to sail the seas of life so that all may experience God’s embrace” (Homily for the Beginning of the Pontificate, May 18, 2025).

Our Diocese is blessed to ordain three men to the priesthood this year. We still need more gifted young men to say “Yes” to God’s call. In working with Vocation Ministries this past year, it is estimated that our Diocese will need roughly 35-40 men in seminary formation to maintain our current level of priest staffing for our parishes as older priests retire or are affected by health challenges. The journey to the priesthood is a challenging and transformative one. It requires dedication, sacrifice, and a deep commitment to the calling that God places in the hearts of those chosen to serve. However, the financial reality of this journey can be daunting. The annual cost for one man in formation for the priesthood exceeds \$46,000.

Our support of these men does not stop once they are ordained. After a lifetime of service to the Church and our Diocese, our retired priests also have needs during their twilight years. Priests living in the Retirement Residence enjoy safe, comfortable housing and freshly prepared meals, among other nominal amenities, at little cost to them.

You can support our future priests, and our retired priests, through your prayers and your generous financial gift to our annual **Pentecost Collection**. By contributing to this collection, you are affirming the importance of vocations and the clergy in our parishes and communities. You are helping to foster an environment where young men can pursue their calling without the burden of financial stress while enabling priests to enjoy retirement after a lifetime of service.

Please prayerfully consider how you can contribute to this important collection and join me in prayer for our clergy, who dedicate their lives to serving us. Pray for those young men who are discerning their call to the priesthood, that they may find the courage and clarity they need to take the next step, and for our retired priests, that they may enjoy their days of relaxation after a life of service.
