SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Normally Baptisms are held on the first Sunday of each month, after our 11:00 am Mass, or approximately at 12:00 Noon. At least one sponsor must be a practicing Catholic, age 16 or older, Confirmed, and must present a sponsor certificate if from another parish. Parents must be registered members of St. Leo's parish.

SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY

Couples contemplating marriage must contact Monsignor Hahn at the Parish Office at least one year before the date of the intended marriage. Church date and arrangements should precede all other wedding plans.

SACRAMENT OF ANOINTING

Call any parish priest as soon as there is any serious illness.

When a parishioner is confined to home because of illness, advanced age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office and arrangements will be made to bring Holy Communion to the person.

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

As the current candidates for the Permanent Diaconate are completing their final year of formation, I am pleased to announce that a new cohort of Candidates for the Permanent Diaconate will begin their formation at the end of August 2026.

I encourage men throughout the Diocese of Harrisburg who have discerned that they may be called to serve the Church as deacons, to make an appointment to meet with their pastor and discuss this possibility. Candidates must be Catholics in good standing who have received all the Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation, and Holy Communion), are committed disciples of Jesus Christ, and who are prayerful and active in the Church. Candidates should be between the ages of 30 and 62, healthy, educated, financially stable, registered in a parish in the Diocese of Harrisburg, and, if married, in a mature, valid, and stable marriage. Single applicants must be ready to contemplate lifelong celibacy, and married applicants must understand that following ordination, if a deacon's wife predeceases him, he will remain celibate.

Applications are available to those who are discerning the Permanent Diaconate only through their pastors. Applications will be available this month and must be submitted no later than March 15, 2026.

Those who are interested in learning more about the Permanent Diaconate or the application and formation process are encouraged to attend one of three information sessions that will be held in the diocese:

- Sunday, January 25, 2025, at 2:00 pm at San Juan Bautista Parish, 425 S. Duke Street, Lancaster
- Tuesday, January 27, 2026, at 6:00 pm at the Diocesan Center, 4800 Union Deposit Road, Harrisburg
- Sunday, February 15, 2026, at 2:00 pm at Saint Pius X Parish, 112 Fairview Drive, Selinsgrove

I invite all the faithful of our Diocese to join me in praying for our brothers who may be discerning a call to the Permanent Diaconate and for their families. Pray that God will continue to provide deacons to serve our people who pattern their lives after the heart of Jesus, "who came not to be served, but to serve." (Matthew 20:28)

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

On this Martin Luther King, Jr. Day, we pause once again to honor the enduring legacy of a leader whose courage and faith transformed our nation and awakened the conscience of the world. Dr. King's steadfast commitment to justice, equality, and nonviolence invites each of us to contemplate the inherent dignity of every human person, created in the image and likeness of God.

Last November, our Holy Father reminded us, "The peace Jesus brings is like a fire, and it asks a lot of us. It asks us, first of all, to *take a stand*. Faced with injustice, inequality, where human dignity is trampled underfoot, where the fragile are silenced: take a stand. To hope is to take a stand. To hope is to understand in our hearts and show in our actions that things must not continue as before."¹

In a world too often marked by division, mistrust, and fear, Dr. King's example remains a powerful reminder that peace and justice are inseparable. His words - "darkness cannot drive out darkness; only light can do that. Hate cannot drive out hate; only love can do that (MLK Day 2025: Reflections of Dr. King's Dream - The Baltimore Times)" - continue to challenge us to meet hatred and prejudice not with bitterness or indifference, but with love rooted in truth and grounded in faith.

The call to bridge divides is not a mere ideal; it lies at the heart of our Christian discipleship. Christ calls us to love not only those who are easy to love, but also those who are different from us, those whom society may overlook, and those whose cries for justice remain unanswered. In working to heal the wounds of racism and prejudice, we join in Christ's ministry of reconciliation and bear witness to the unity for which He prayed.

Racism, in all its forms, wounds the Body of Christ and obstructs the flourishing of all people. It diminishes our shared humanity and obscures the truth that every person is a beloved child of God. Today and every day, we are called to examine our own hearts, to repent of attitudes and actions that divide, and confront the sin of racism wherever it persists. Together, we must strive to build a society founded on justice, mutual respect, and peace.

As followers of Christ in the Diocese of Harrisburg, let us renew our commitment to fostering communities of welcome, compassion, and understanding. May Dr. King's example inspire each of us to be instruments of God's peace — to break down walls of division, to heal hearts wounded by prejudice, and to affirm the sacred dignity of every human life. Let us pray that the Holy Spirit guides our steps toward unity, and that our shared challenges reflect the light of Christ in a world longing for hope.
