SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Parishioners who would like to have their child baptized at St. Leo's are requested to call Monsignor Hahn at the Parish Office to personally schedule an appointment to meet with him to discuss this great Sacrament. Normally Baptisms are held on the first Sunday of each month, after our 11:00 am Mass, or approximately at 12:00 Noon. At least one sponsor must be a practicing Catholic, age 16 or older, Confirmed, and must present a sponsor certificate if from another parish. Parents must be registered members of St. Leo's parish.

SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY

Couples contemplating marriage must contact Monsignor Hahn at the Parish Office at least one year before the date of the intended marriage. Church date and arrangements should precede all other wedding plans.

SACRAMENT OF ANOINTING

Call any parish priest as soon as there is any serious illness.

HOLY COMMUNION TO THE SICK

When a parishioner is confined to home because of illness, advanced age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office and arrangements will be made to bring Holy Communion to the person.

ORDER OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS (OCIA)

Adults interested in learning more about their faith or in becoming Catholic may join the program of formation and instruction which begins in September. Call the Religious Education Office.

“Hosanna to the Son of David; blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord; hosanna in the highest.” (Matt 21:7)

Today, we begin Holy Week with our solemn celebration of Palm Sunday. It is the only Liturgy in our entire year that we have two Gospels proclaimed, recounting two most dramatically different events. In the first Gospel, we hear of the Lord’s triumphant entry into Jerusalem. The crowd hails Him, the “prophet from Nazareth, in Galilee.”

But then, there is the second Gospel, the account of His Passion, when that same crowd now cries out “let him be crucified.” And while these two diverse scenes recount actual events in history, aren’t they also symbolic, in a way, about our lives of faith? Sometimes we are filled with great faith and fervor, we live out the call to follow Christ with great fidelity, hailing Him as our Lord. But then, sometimes, we fail in the call to follow Him, don’t we? We act, maybe even like Peter a bit, denying in our actions that we even know Him.

And so, it is against this background of our wavering in our commitment to the Lord, that we are meant to marvel at His commitment to us!

In the Garden, He prays, “Father, if it is possible, let this cup pass from me; yet, not as I will, but as you will.” He and the Father are One, so His will is to do the Father’s will and yet, in His humanity, He cannot help but be wary of that excruciating pain and death He is about to undergo. Yet, He irrepressibly continues to fulfill His Father’s Plan to save all humanity.

We now come to this Holy Week and the culmination of Lent, the saving action of Christ on His Cross and His resurrection are about to be recalled by us with particular focus, in what the Church calls the “Paschal Triduum”. We will begin this Thursday evening with the Mass of the Lord’s Supper, recalling Our Lord’s institution of the Sacraments of Holy Orders and the Holy Eucharist, continue on Good Friday, with the Commemoration of the Lord’s Passion, and then come to Holy Saturday and the indescribable joy of Easter Sunday.

On a personal note, I want to express my deepest thanks to all who have so faithfully tried to make this Season of Lent a special one. So many of you continue to inspire me as I see you live out your faith, so fully. You have shown such beautiful devotion in so many ways over these weeks: your attendance at Stations of the Cross, coming to our Forty Hours Devotions, and helping to prepare and attend our Friday evening Lenten Meals. So many of you have contributed to our Diocesan Annual Campaign, and on behalf of our Bishop, I thank you for your generosity.

Now, we come together to begin this final week, this week we call “Holy”. I pray that for all of us, these days may take on special meaning and that we will celebrate them with special attention and devotion. May we seek to more closely follow Christ, seeing that He has joined Himself to us in all our sufferings, so that one day, like Him, we will be brought through the trial and agony of our death, to the eternal life of His resurrection. God bless you.
