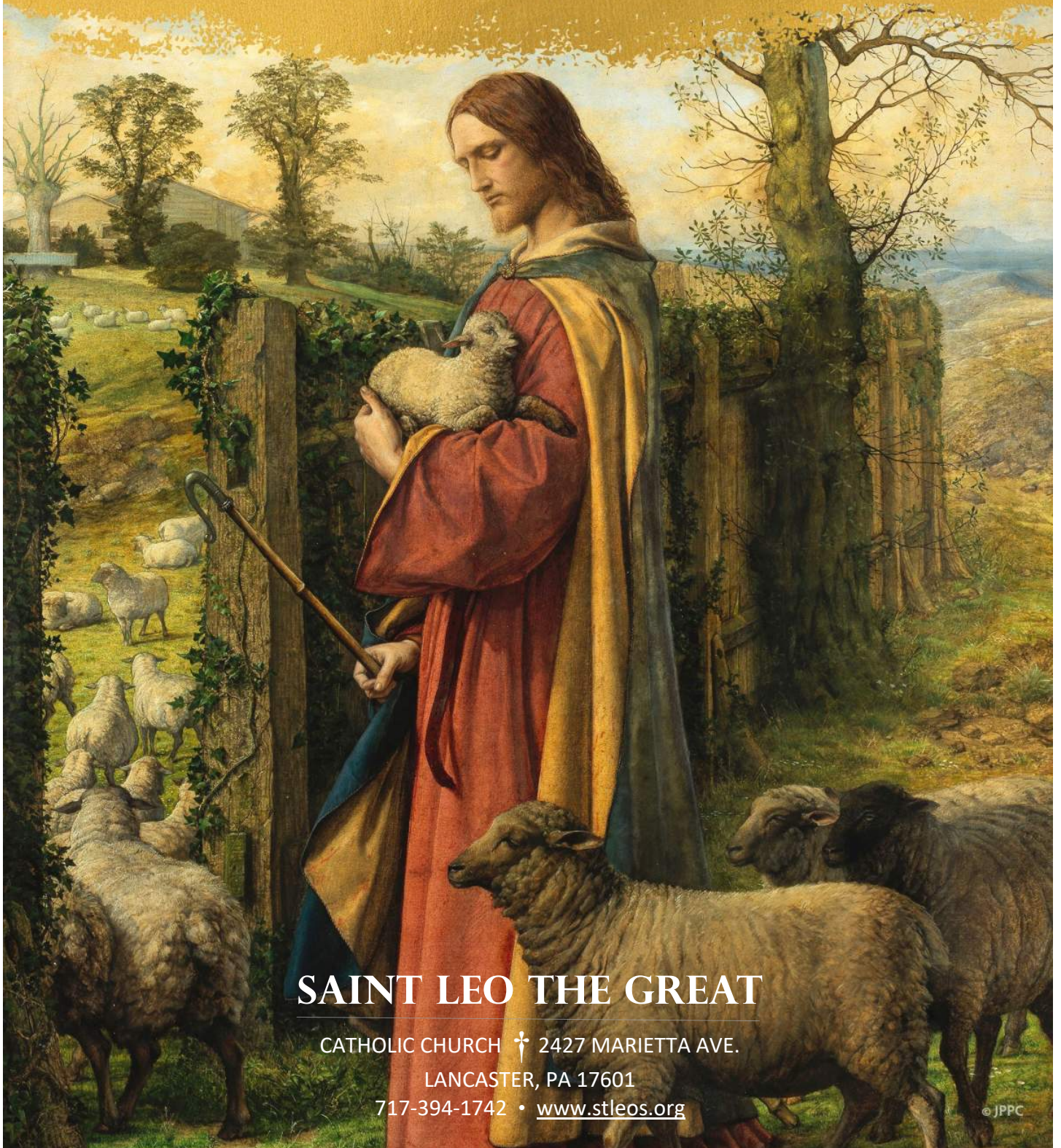

SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Parishioners who would like to have their child baptized at St. Leo's are requested to call Monsignor Hahn at the Parish Office to personally schedule an appointment to meet with him to discuss this great Sacrament. Normally Baptisms are held on the first Sunday of each month, after our 11:00 am Mass, or approximately at 12:00 Noon. At least one sponsor must be a practicing Catholic, age 16 or older, Confirmed, and must present a sponsor certificate if from another parish. Parents must be registered members of St. Leo's parish.

SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY

Couples contemplating marriage must contact Monsignor Hahn at the Parish Office at least one year before the date of the intended marriage. Church date and arrangements should precede all other wedding plans.

SACRAMENT OF ANOINTING

Call any parish priest as soon as there is any serious illness.

HOLY COMMUNION TO THE SICK

When a parishioner is confined to home because of illness, advanced age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office and arrangements will be made to bring Holy Communion to the person.

ORDER OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS (OCIA)

Adults interested in learning more about their faith or in becoming Catholic may join the program of formation and instruction which begins in September. Call the Religious Education Office.

Letters of recommendation for sponsors of the Sacraments can be issued only to active registered members of the parish and who are receiving the Sacraments on a regular basis.

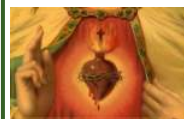



Sacramental Policy for the Reception of Confirmation and Holy Eucharist:

Preparation for the Sacraments of Confirmation and Holy Eucharist is a two-year program as prescribed by the Diocese of Harrisburg. To be eligible to receive the sacrament of Confirmation, your child must have completed the 7th and 8th grade years of instruction and to receive the sacrament of Holy Eucharist your child must have completed the 1st and 2nd grade years of instruction at either our Parish Elementary School or our Parish School of Religion. Homilist

Paschal Reality and the Presence of Christ

Fr. Christopher Sahd is the son of Ron and Karen Sahd. He grew up in Columbia, PA and went to Holy Trinity School and Lancaster Catholic High School, graduating in 1991. There are four boys in the family. Dan and his wife Deb run Sahd Metal Recycling. The other two brothers are twins, and both are priests within the Diocese of Harrisburg. Fr. Kyle Sahd is pastor at St. Joseph's in York and Fr. Tim Sahd is pastor at Seven Sorrows in Middletown.

Fr. Christopher was ordained in Scranton in 2001. He entered the Basilian Salvatorian Order in 2021. This is a religious order of the Eastern Rite, the Melkites. The order is centered in the country of Lebanon. The Melkites originated with the Council of Chalcedon in 451 and remained in communion with Rome during the schism between Catholicism and Orthodoxy.

The term Melkite roughly translates to "followers of the king," because it was the Byzantine emperor who convened the Council of Chalcedon. In the 1720s, the Melkite Church officially split between Orthodox and Catholic branches. The Melkite Church is one of the 23 Eastern Catholic churches, all of which are governed by the pope.

WHAT IS 40 HOURS?

Traditionally, each parish sets aside three days of the year for the faithful to gather together for personal and public prayer. The focus of these three days is to spend time in adoration of our Lord in the Blessed Sacrament and to reflect on the centrality of the Eucharistic life of the Church. Although originally forty, today the hours are adjusted according to the parish's needs.
