## SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Parishioners who would like to have their child baptized at St. Leo's are requested to call Monsignor Hahn at the Parish Office to personally schedule an appointment to meet with him to discuss this great Sacrament. Normally Baptisms are held on the first Sunday of each month, after our 11:00 am Mass, or approximately at 12:00 Noon. At least one sponsor must be a practicing Catholic, age 16 or older, Confirmed, and must present a sponsor certificate if from another parish. Parents must be registered members of St. Leo's parish.

## SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY

Couples contemplating marriage must contact Monsignor Hahn at the Parish Office at least one year before the date of the intended marriage. Church date and arrangements should precede all other wedding plans.

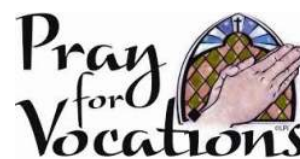

### Sacramental Policy for the Reception of Confirmation and Holy Eucharist:

Preparation for the Sacraments of Confirmation and Holy Eucharist is a two-year program as prescribed by the Diocese of Harrisburg. To be eligible to receive the sacrament of Confirmation, your child must have completed the 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade years of instruction and to receive the sacrament of Holy Eucharist your child must have completed the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> grade years of instruction at either our Parish Elementary School or our Parish School of Religion. ## Feast Day Mass of Saints Thomas More and John Fisher, Martyrs

The Saint Thomas More Society of Central Pennsylvania is an organization of Catholic lawyers, judges, public office holders, paralegals, legal assistants, and law students. The Society respectfully invites you to attend the Feast Day Mass of Saints Thomas More and John Fisher.

The Mass will be celebrated by Reverend Timothy Sahd, on **Monday, June 22, 2026 at 8 a.m.** at Seven Sorrows of the Blessed Virgin Mary Church in Middletown. Mass will be preceded by an all-night Adoration of the Most Blessed Sacrament from 10 p.m. Sunday to an hour before Mass. Adoration will be in the rectory chapel on 280 N. Race St., Middletown. Light refreshments will be served after Mass. The public is welcome to participate in all events.

The purpose of this Mass, held at the start of Religious Freedom Week, is to gather to pray for God's guidance and to invoke blessings, through the intercession of Thomas More and John Fisher, upon those who work in the administration of justice or government.

## The Rule of Saint Romuald - Feast Day, June 19

Saint Romuald lived during the 11th century and was a prominent figure in establishing the ascetic practices of hermits. In the year 1006, Saint Bruno received the following "Brief Rule" from Master Romuald, which he himself was very careful to practice throughout his life. These seven-steps for novice-hermits comprise a set of exercises for training in contemplation:

1. Sit in the cell as in paradise. (Posture, place, solitude, inner peace & joy)
2. Cast all memory of the world behind you. (Detachment and liberation for concentration)
3. Cautiously watching your thoughts, as a good fisher watches the fish. (Self-observation & analysis for purity of mind and heart)
4. In the Psalms there is one way. Do not abandon it. If you who have come with the fervor of a novice cannot understand everything, strive to recite with understanding of spirit and mind, now here, now there, and when you begin to wander while reading, do not stop, but hasten to correct yourself by concentrating. (Praying the Psalms as seeds of meditation)
5. Above all, place yourself in the presence of God with fear and trembling, like someone who stands in the sight of the emperor. (Reverent, compunctious practice of the presence of God)
6. Destroy yourself completely. (Intensive ascetical inner overcoming of faults)
7. And sit like a chick, content with the grace of God, for unless its mother gives it something, it tastes nothing and has nothing to eat. (Childlike humility and receptivity to grace.)

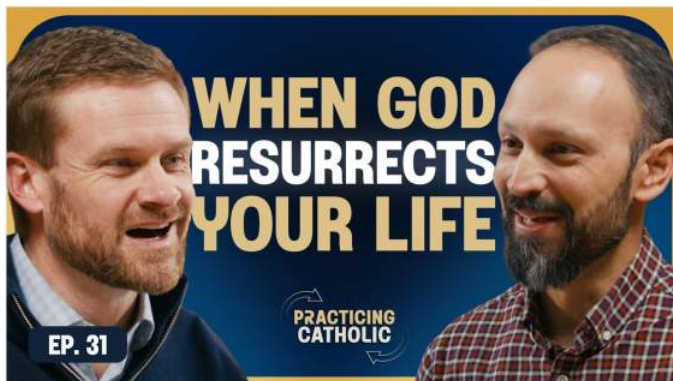
