SACRAMENT OF BAPTISM

Parishioners who would like to have their child baptized at St. Leo's are requested to call Monsignor Hahn at the Parish Office to personally schedule an appointment to meet with him to discuss this great Sacrament. Normally Baptisms are held on the first Sunday of each month, after our 11:00 am Mass, or approximately at 12:00 Noon. At least one sponsor must be a practicing Catholic, age 16 or older, Confirmed, and must present a sponsor certificate if from another parish. Parents must be registered members of St. Leo's parish.

SACRAMENT OF MATRIMONY

Couples contemplating marriage must contact Monsignor Hahn at the Parish Office at least one year before the date of the intended marriage. Church date and arrangements should precede all other wedding plans.

SACRAMENT OF ANOINTING

Call any parish priest as soon as there is any serious illness.

When a parishioner is confined to home because of illness, advanced age or infirmity, please call the Parish Office and arrangements will be made to bring Holy Communion to the person.

Testimony of Alessandro Serenelli, (Saint Maria Goretti's attacker) dated May 5, 1961

I'm nearly 80 years old. I'm about to depart. Looking back at my past, I can see that in my early youth, I chose a bad path which led me to ruin myself. My behavior was influenced by print, mass-media, and bad examples which are followed by the majority of young people without even thinking. And I did the same. I was not worried.

There were a lot of generous and devoted people who surrounded me, but I paid no attention to them because a violent force blinded me and pushed me toward a wrong way of life. When I was 20 years old, I committed a crime of passion. Now, that memory represents something horrible for me. Maria Goretti, now a Saint, was my good angel, sent to me through Providence to guide and save me. I still have impressed upon my heart her words of rebuke and of pardon. She prayed for me, she interceded for her murderer. Thirty years of prison followed.

If I had been of age, I could have spent all my life in prison. I accepted to be condemned because it was my own fault.

Little Maria was really my light, my protectress; with her help, I behaved well during the 27 years of prison and tried to live honestly when I was again accepted among the members of society. The brothers of St. Francis, Capuchins from Marche, welcomed me with angelic charity into their monastery as a brother, not as a servant. I've been living with their community for 24 years, and now I am serenely waiting to witness the vision of God, to hug my loved ones again, and to be next to my Guardian Angel and her dear mother, Assunta.

I hope this letter that I wrote can teach others the happy lesson of avoiding evil and of always following the right path, like little children. I feel that religion with its precepts is not something we can live without, but rather it is the real comfort, the real strength in life and the only safe way in every circumstance, even the most painful ones of life.

On July 5, 1902 eleven year old Maria Goretti was mortally wounded by her twenty year old neighbor, Alessandro Serenelli, who attacked her with intent to sexually abuse her. Doctors tried to save her. The last twenty hours of her life were spent in suffering, praying for Alessandro and forgiving him. Maria was canonized by Pope Pius XII on June 24, 1950. She is the youngest person ever to be canonized. Her Feast Day is July 6th.

Daily Prayer for America 250

By Cardinal Raymond L. Burke

O Sacred Heart of Jesus, King of Heaven and Earth, I come before You on the 250th Anniversary of the signing of the Declaration of Independence that established my nation, the United States of America, upon the truths that liberty is the gift of my Creator, You Who, with the Father and the Holy Spirit, are the Sovereign Lord of History and the Redeemer of the World, and that my true homeland is not this world but is Your Eternal Kingdom, the true destiny of every people, of every nation.

With sorrow, I acknowledge the many sins by which my nation has offended You: the failure to safeguard and foster innocent and defenseless human life, the profanation of marriage and its fruit, the family, the denial of man's very identity as male and female created in Your image, after Your likeness (Gen 1, 27), and the denial of the right to worship You in accord with a well-formed conscience. In short, I confess with sorrow that my homeland has turned away from Your eternal law of truth and love, the only way to liberty, to our eternal homeland. With a contrite heart, I implore Your mercy upon my homeland, that she may be purified of her infidelities and be restored in fidelity to You.

Under the mantle of Our Lady of Guadalupe, Your Virgin Mother and the Patroness of the Americas, and through her Immaculate Heart, I beg You to bless anew my nation, founded in accord with Your Divine Providence and dedicated to the truth that all people are created by You with equal dignity as Your children, and that they are endowed by You with the right to life, liberty, and the pursuit of happiness. Grant that the United States of America may remain faithful to its founding vision, not in the "pride of life" (1 John 2, 16), but in humble dependence upon You Who alone secure justice, establish peace, and preserve freedom.

O Sacred Heart of Jesus, reign in my home and in my nation. Strengthen every Catholic to live the truths of the faith in public and in private, so that America may be renewed in holiness and her liberty may be safeguarded by obedience to Your eternal law of truth and love. Guided by the Immaculate Heart of Mary, I place into Your Sacred Heart, pierced for love of man, our families, our leaders, and their future: rule over us with justice and mercy, protect the most innocent and vulnerable, sustain marriage and family life, teach us to respect our identity as Your children, male and female, and draw every heart into communion with You by worshiping You "in spirit and truth" (Jn 4, 24). Have mercy upon my nation and upon the whole world, so that Your eternal truth and love, Your justice and peace, may triumph throughout the land now and forever, until the day when "the kingdom of the world" has become Your Kingdom in which You "shall reign forever and ever" (Rev 11, 15). 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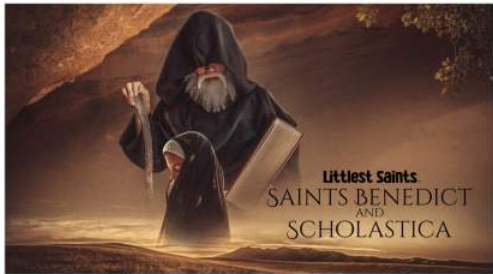
